Principal's Message

Dilworth Family,

Just a reminder that tomorrow, Tuesday Oct. 5th, is an Asynchronous day. Students will stay at home. They will have been provided with work packets by their teachers to complete. These will also be used to track attendance. Please have your student(s) complete the work and get it turned in on Wednesday so that they are marked as attending school. This is a requirement from the state. We appreciate your help in this.

During the school day tomorrow teachers in grades K-3 are working on LETRS training as required by the state. This is reading intervention and instruction training that we feel will help teachers in their instruction of reading. The teachers in grades 4-6 will be participating in training in the Acadience math assessment. This training will help teachers understand data collected from the assessment and then use that data to inform the instruction they give students in small groups tailored to each student's needs.

Even though tomorrow is an Asynchronous day, meals will be provided in a "grab and go" style. You may come pick up meals at the school between 10:00 am and 12:00 pm tomorrow. Please use the East cafeteria doors as we did last year during the online portion of the school year.
