SCC MEETING MINUTES OCT. 27, 2020

1.Minutes of the previous meeting will be approved by email.

2. ENROLLMENT NUMBERS: Enrollment is down from last year.

Kindergarten – 63 1^{st} grade – 68 2^{nd} grade – 56 3^{rd} grade – 50 4^{th} grade – 73 5^{th} grade – 77 6^{th} grade – 80 TOTAL # OF STUDENTS IS 467.

Students are enrolling in other district schools as well as some are moving out of state. Funding for the district is based on enrollment on Oct. 1st. This year because of the circumstances, funding and staffing won't be impacted but next year will have to be looked at.

The question was asked about the district's next plans to bring students back into the schools. There has been some talk of phasing in Pre-K – 3rd grade around the middle of November. This week's Board meeting will have some doctors giving their opinions if young children can spread the virus in a classroom setting.

A question was asked about attendance and how that was taken. The teacher takes the attendance of the students that show up in her Zoom classroom. The students that don't Zoom into class but are doing work at home have an exit ticket that they submit to the teacher who then counts them as attending school.

Small groups are taking place at school and seem to be working very well. These are students in grades K-3rd grade.

3. <u>TRUST LAND FUNDS</u>: Our Trust Land application has been approved. Do we need to make any amendments to our Trust Land proposal? We are asking for funds to pay for Paraprofessionals as well as the art program here at school.

There is a need for more devices in the classroom for when the students come back into school. We don't have enough devices for teachers to teach students in the classroom and students who choose to do online learning.

This will be discussed in SIC to see what can be done to acquire more devices without cutting our art program and paraprofessionals.

It was suggested that we hold our SCC meeting on the 4th Tuesday at 7:15 a.m. This was agreed upon.
